BUILDING for TOMORROW Campaign FAQs

What are the capital projects to be funded?

The campaign will fund urgently needed repairs to the water line; replacement of the large church window and the wood framing; and replacement of the existing septic system.

What is the total estimated cost for all three projects?

We estimate a total cost of \$100,000 for all three projects. Any funds left after the projects have been completed will be used to fund additional capital improvement needs such as boiler repairs, parking lot repairs, and others.

Can't we cover these expenses with the parish's annual stewardship campaign and/or its regular weekly offering?

Both the parish's annual stewardship campaign and the regular weekly offering are needed to support our operating budget and are not enough to meet the capital needs of the parish.

What is the campaign timeframe?

The campaign launches on Sunday, February 19, 2023, and runs through Lent into spring.

Will we need to wait until the full amount is raised before starting these projects?

We will begin work on each of the projects as soon as we have sufficient funds to do so.

Can someone set up auto-debit from their bank accounts or use a credit card for the campaign?

Just as you can make auto-debit or credit card contributions for regular giving, you can designate auto-debit or credit card contributions for this capital campaign as well, either via PayPal or securely our parish website by scanning the QR Code below.

Can donations be made in stocks?

Yes, gifts of appreciated stocks are greatly appreciated. Contact the parish Treasurer for more information.

Can someone donate from a tax-qualified plan?

Those age 70½ and over may make a qualified charitable distribution from an IRA and avoid paying income taxes on the distribution.
